Kindergarten Gear Up is a county initiative that was started with a one-year grant through the California State Library about three years ago.

According to statistics, about 40% of children between the ages 3-5 do not attend preschool. Therefore, Kindergarten Gear Up is a great way to help these children gain those social and emotional skills in a story time setting, in addition to learning early literacy skills.

The goal is to help children learn how to be more independent and to be better prepared for Kindergarten.

"I'd Rather Be Reading" T-Shirts are now available for purchase in both men's and women's sizes for \$15. They are in the library and make a great gift for any book lover.



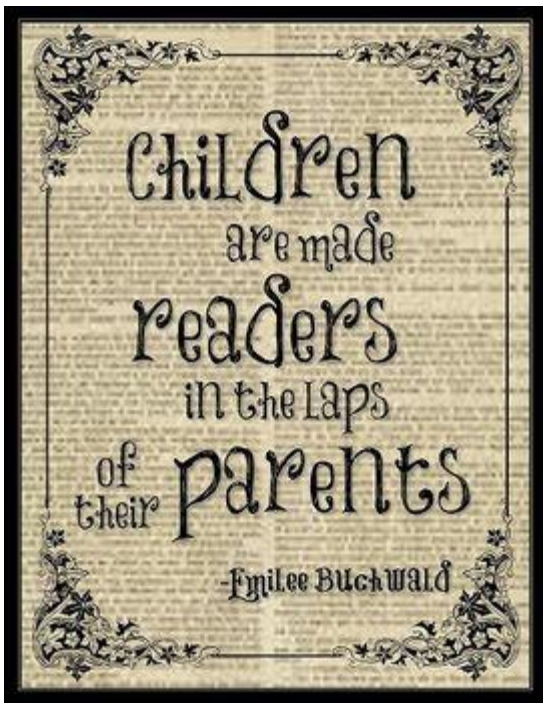

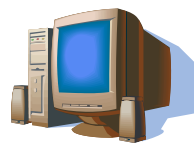
Bingo Wednesday night, April 3rd & 17th at 6:00 pm. **It's free!!**
