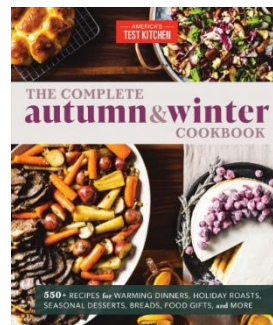
Also, in October we will be hosting a special event program on October 15th - **Fall in Love with Your**

A gentle reminder that all programming right now is limited to adults and teens 12 and up.

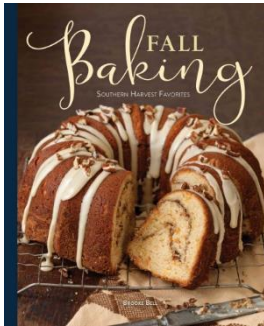
Coming Soon: our Youth Services Librarian is hard at work planning a few teen events for the Fall!

Fall calls to mind cozy, warm meals so here are some great cookbooks for fall weather:

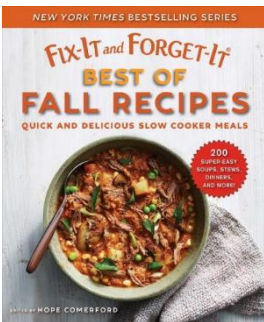

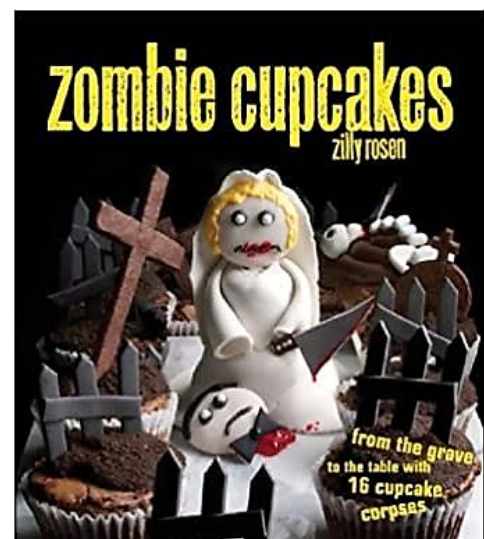

Mia begins an investigation with unexpected results that endanger Mia's life.

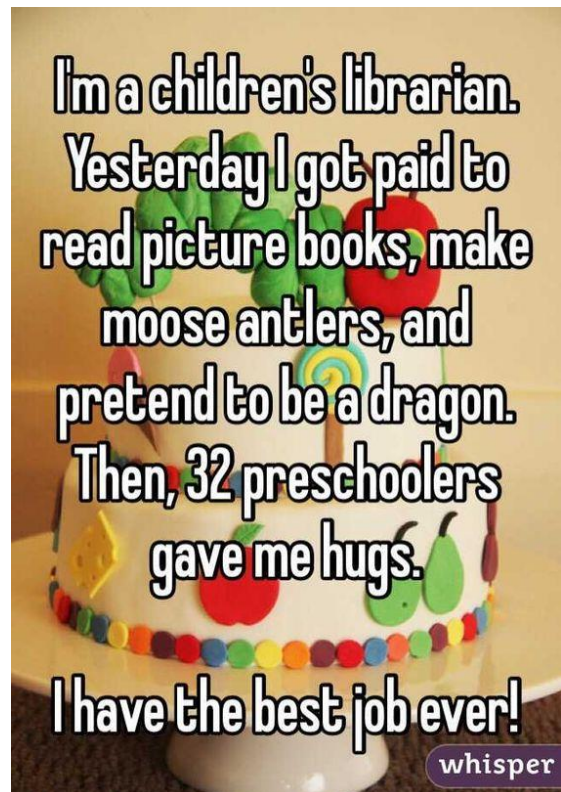
